



All products are as follows:

1. Hydrogen generation through Water Electrolysis
 - (i) Product – Hydrogen gas
 - (ii) Process – Alkaline Water Hydrolysis.
 - (iii) Fuel – Electricity
 - (iv) Use of Water – Treated Water for Electrolysis.
 - (v) Waste Water – Waste Water from cooling towers and cooling-re-circulation processes.
 - (vi) Hazardous Waste – Used Electrodes and Used Chemicals will be generated in approx. 4-5 years.

Air Pollution Score (A) = A1 + A2 = 0		
3. Hazardous Waste Score (HW)		
Score	Hazardous Waste Category	Value
HW	HW1	10
Grand Total = W+A+HW = 10 + 0 + 10 = 20		

$$\text{Total Pollution Index (Normalized Score)} = \frac{100 \times (W+HW)}{60} = 39.33$$
